He is the author or co-author of a dozen articles published in both technical journals and nontechnical publications. He enjoys hunting, fishing, hiking, biking, doing things with his family, and exploring rocks in Alaska, the Grand Canyon, and the eastern mountains of West Virginia.



Answers in Genesis Historian & Bible Teacher – Dr. Terry Mortenson has an MDiv from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School and a PhD in the history of geology from Coventry University in England. Editor of and contributor to two multi-author books on Genesis, he has also published a book (based on his PhD thesis) and many articles and book chapters on the philosophical, historical, and theological aspects of the origins debate. After serving with Campus Crusade for Christ for 26 years (mostly in Eastern Europe), he joined the staff of Answers in Genesis in 2001 as a speaker, writer, and researcher.
